

## Acceptable Demolition Waste

- Bituminous concrete (includes asphalt pavement and blacktop)
- Built-in cabinetry
- Ceiling tile
- Ceramic items
- Concrete (including rebar)
- Conduit and pipes
- Drain tile
- Duct work
- Electrical wiring and components
- Glass (limited to window and door glass from buildings and structures)
- Insulation (Includes fiberglass, mineral wool, cellulose, polystyrene and newspaper.)
- Masonry (bricks, stucco and plaster)
- Molded fiberglass
- Plastic building parts
- Plumbing fixtures
- Roofing materials
- Rubber
- Sheathing
- Shingles
- Siding (Includes vinyl, masonite, untreated wood, aluminum and steel.)
- Stone
- Uncontaminated soil
- Untreated wood (including painted, stained and/or varnished dimensional lumber,
- Wall board, sheet rock
- Wall coverings
- Wood and vinyl flooring (pallets, particle board, plywood,)

## Unacceptable Demolition Waste

- Adhesive (including applicators, containers, and tubes)
- Animal carcasses, parts, or rendering and slaughterhouse wastes
- Appliances (Including clothes washers and dryers, dishwashers, hot water heaters, furnaces and heat pumps, garbage disposals, trash compactors, conventional and microwave ovens, ranges and stoves, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, refrigerators and freezers).
- Asbestos-containing materials
- Ashes or wastes
- Batteries
- Cardboard
- Carpet and Padding
- Chemical containers
- Epoxy (Incl. applicators, containers, tubes)
- Fluorescent tubes and ballasts
- Furniture
- Hazardous wastes
- High intensity discharge lamps
- Household refuse or garbage
- Liquids of any type
- Mattresses
- Packaging materials (Incl. cardboard, paper, shrink wrap, styrofoam)
- Paint, thinners, solvents, varnishes
- PCB (Polychlorinated Biphenyl)
- Petroleum products, containers, or filters (including oil, grease, and fuel)
- Sandblasting waste
- Sealants (Incl. applicators, containers, tubes)

- Slate siding (asbestos)
- Sludges of any type
- Street sweepings
- Tar (Incl. applicators, containers, tubes)
- Thermostats and switches containing mercury
- Tires
- Treated lumber/wood (Incl. decking, railroad ties)
- Yard wastes
